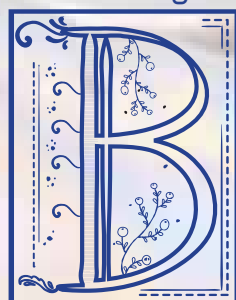

Several of us were supplying the bagels and extra lox in case we consumed more than the 2.5 pounds supplied by the college for \$45. And, most of the time both of the bagels and extra lox were donated because we did not have money for reimbursement. We believe the new price will just about meet our costs, even though we will be supplying them with all the lox. Otherwise, if they supplied the lox, the cost would be about \$14.50, and that would not include the tip.

For this new price, you will have many options not available at FSC. The Heights has a brunch with omelets made to order. Eggs Benedict and a lot of treif (non-Kosher meat) for those who cannot forgo the opportunity to eat bacon, sausage, or Eggs Benedict. We will be charged the \$12.50 whether or not you eat lox and bagels so please pay us and not the restaurant. The \$12.50 includes the tip (18 percent) and tax, if any. The room is more than adequate to hold our meetings as it is where my Kiwanis meets for breakfast, often with 50 or more in attendance.

Please come and check out our new digs when bagel brunches resume in September and let us know how you feel about our change.

Directions: Since you have been to our brunches before, I will assume you can find Bartow Road (US 98 South) that runs from Lakeland to Bartow .

From either direction turn west on Edgewood Drive. Continue west for about two miles until you reach Buckingham Avenue.

Turn left on Buckingham and the Club is on your left. You may park in the lower (north) or upper (south) parking lot.

There is an easy ramp on the south side of the building. We will be in the southeast corner of the restaurant. The Masters Room. Address is 2900 Buckingham Avenue, Lakeland.

If you live in Lakeland, you probably already know that Edgewood Drive runs between South Florida Avenue (as well as Harden Boulevard) and Bartow Road.
